



Payment & Attendance Policies

Tuition: Due by the 1st of each month. Total tuition is divided up into equal payments each month throughout the ballet year, regardless of how many classes are held that month.

45 Minute Class: \$35/month

60 Minute Class: \$40/month

75 Minute Class: \$45/month

*Payments may be made in person via cash or check, or paid online.

**Checks should be made out to Petit Ballet Academy, LLC.

***Venmo payment is also available. Submit payment to petit-ballet.

Late Fee: A **\$10 late fee** will apply for any tuition paid after the 1st of the month. Tuition is paid to hold your dancers' place in class. No exceptions.

Registration Fee: A one time (non-refundable) fee of \$20 per family is due with the first month's tuition.

Performance Fee: Due in full by March 1st. \$40/family.

Costume Fee: Due in full by February 1st.

Pre and Kinder Ballet Classes: \$45/student

Beginning and Intermediate Ballet Classes: \$60/student

Attendance Policy: Tuition is owed whether the student attends class or not. Classes may be made up by attending another class during the week. This is the parent's responsibility. No extra make-up classes will be provided this year. If a student quits halfway through the month, no refund will be provided for missed classes that month.

Parents are free to stay and watch class but are asked to remain in the waiting area during class, not in the actual studio*. There are glass doors and windows to see through. Please plan on staying at the studio the entire class time if your child is not FULLY potty trained.
